INSTRUCTIONS FOR ONE TIME MANDATE FORM

One Time Mandate (OTM) is an authorization to the bank issued by an investor to debit their bank account up to a maximum limit as provided by the investor in the OTM mandate.

Instruction to PGIM India Agelinked Investment Asset Allocation Facility

PGIM India Agelinked Investment Asset Allocation facility bundles an Equity and a Debt fund and allocates assets between the two such that the initial allocation favors equity and allocation becomes increasingly conservative as the investor approaches retirement.

Following are the features of the facility:

1. The investor would make the payment to a pool account and the allocation based on the age of the investor would be allocated between one Equity and one Debt fund on the basis of the following formula:
Equity allocation = 100 (minus) – age of the investor
The balance amount would be invested in Debt Scheme
2. This facility is available for all Individual Investor Only.
3. At the time of initial investment into the facility the investor will get the asset allocation according to his/her age. The default period for rebalancing would be 5 years in order to bring the equity level to match with the above mention formula for equity allocation. However the investor will also have an option to choose a different period of rebalancing. The other options available to the investor during initial purchase would be:
 - a. 1 year
 - b. 3 years
 - c. 5 years (Default Option)
 - d. 7 years
4. The default funds for this facility are as mention below:
 - a. Equity - PGIM India Flexi Cap Fund
 - b. Debt - PGIM India Banking and PSU Debt Fund.
5. At the time of initial investment into the facility the investor also has an option to choose from any one of the following funds instead of the default fund :
 - a. Equity -
 - i. PGIM India Large Cap Fund
 - ii. PGIM India Flexi Cap Fund
 - iii. PGIM India Midcap Opportunities Fund
 - iv. PGIM India Hybrid Equity Fund
 - v. PGIM India Balanced Advantage Fund
 - vi. PGIM India Small Cap Fund
 - b. Debt -
 - i. PGIM India Short Duration Fund
 - ii. PGIM India Banking and PSU Debt Fund
 - iii. PGIM India Low Duration Fund
 - iv. PGIM India Arbitrage Fund
 - v. PGIM India Ultra Short Duration Fund
 - vi. PGIM India Equity Savings Fund
 - vii. PGIM India Money Market Fund
6. This facility would be available in default Growth Option.
7. Any additional purchase under this facility, funds will be allocated as per allocation based on the age as on date of investment in the selected Equity and Debt scheme as selected at the time of initial purchase.
8. The source date from which the rebalancing period would be calculated for any such folio would be the 1st transaction date in the folio under the facility. All additional subscriptions in the folio either in the form of lumpsum or SIP would be rebalanced on the date of completion of the selected rebalancing period from the 1st transaction date. For e.g.: if the 1st transaction under the said facility is on 01st January 2018 and subsequently there were additional lumpsum subscriptions in the folio under the same facility on 01st Feb 2018 & 01st March 2018 and also a SIP registration on 01st April 2018, the rebalancing for all the above transactions considering a 5 year rebalancing period will be due on 01st January 2023.
9. The asset allocation is applicable to investors of 30 years and above. Any individual opting for the facility below the age of 30 would get all his investment allocated to the Equity scheme as selected by him/her. This would be rebalanced at the age of Investor attending the age of 30 years or as per the rebalancing period selected by the investor whichever is later. For e.g. if the 1st investment was done at the age of 29 years then the 1st rebalancing will be done at the age of 34 years.
10. The investor can make a complete switch to one of the allowed funds. While switching the investor will be allowed to switch from an equity fund to another of the allowed equity funds. Similarly, he/she would be allowed to switch from a debt fund to another of the allowed debt funds. No switching will be allowed from an equity to a debt fund and from a debt to an equity fund.
11. Partial switch will not be allowed in this facility. In case there is a request for partial switch which comes

from the investor in folio under this facility, that request will be rejected.

12. In case of Switch from Equity 1 to Equity 2 wherein the investment is through the SIP route, all future SIP's are processed under Equity 2. Investor shall not provide any separate instruction for the same.
 13. There is no end date to this facility. Once the funds are invested, the corpus would get allocated according to the recommended asset allocation till the time the corpus remains invested with PGIM India Mutual Fund.
 14. The minimum amount under the said facility would be Rs.5,000/- for lumpsum and Rs.2,000/- for SIP. Minimum 12 instalments for monthly frequency. Minimum 6 instalments for quarterly frequency.
 15. There will be no lock-in or additional exit load for the scheme apart from the loads currently applicable to the underlying funds as per scheme information document.

Pursuant to SEBI circular dated September 13, 2012, mutual funds have created a unique identity number of the employee/ relationship manager/ sales person of the distributor interacting with the investor for the sale of mutual fund products, in addition to the AMFI Registration Number (ARN) of the distributor. This Employee Unique Identification Number is referred as "EUIN". EUIN aims to assist in tackling the problem of mis-selling even if the employee/relationship manager/sales person leaves the employment of the distributor or his/her sub broker. Distributors are advised to ensure that the sub broker affixes his/her ARN code in the column "Sub broker ARN code" separately provided, in addition to the current practice of affixing the internal code issued by the main ARN holder in the "Sub broker code (as allotted by ARN holder)" column and the EUIN of the Sales Person (if any) in the "EUIN" column.
 - e. Distributors are advised to ensure that they fill in the RIA code, in case they are a Registered Investment Advisor.
 - f. Investors are requested to note that EUIN is applicable for transactions such as Purchases, Switches, Registrations of SIP / STP and EUIN is not applicable for transactions such as Installments under SIP/ STP / SWP / Dividend Reinvestments, Redemption, SWP Registration.
 - g. Investors are requested to note that EUIN is largely applicable to sales persons of non individual ARN holders only (whether acting in the capacity of the main distributor or sub broker). 2. TRANSACTION CHARGES

In terms of SEBI circular, Cir/ IMD/ DF/13/ 2011 dated August 22, 2011, the distributors of mutual fund products are allowed to be paid transaction charges for purchase transactions :

- @ Rs. 100/- per subscription of Rs. 10,000/- and above in respect of existing unitholders; and
- @ Rs. 150/- for subscription of Rs. 10,000/- and above in respect of a first time investor in mutual funds.

In case of SIPs, the transaction charge if any, shall be applicable only if the total commitment through SIPs aggregates to Rs. 10,000/- and above and shall be recovered in 4 installments. The transaction charge shall be deducted from the subscription amount and paid to the distributor; and the balance shall be invested in the Scheme. The transaction charges and the net investment amount and the number of units allotted will be clearly mentioned in the Account Statement issued by the Mutual Fund. There shall be no transaction charges on

- (i) 'Direct' investments;
- (ii) subscription below Rs. 10,000/- and
- (iii) switch (including STP) and redemption (including SWP) transactions.

Distributors shall be able to choose to opt out of charging the transaction charge. However, the 'opt-out' shall be at distributor level and not investor level i.e. a distributor shall not charge one investor and choose not to charge another investor.

Non-Resident Indians residing in the Financial Action Task Force (FATF) Non Compliant Countries and Territories (NCCTs) & Overseas Corporate Bodies.

d. KYC Requirements And Details:

Central Registry of Securitisation and Asset Reconstruction and Security interest of India (CERSAI) has been authorised by Government of India to act as Central KYC Records Registry under Prevention of Money-Laundering (Maintenance of Records) Rules, 2005 (PMLA Rules).

SEBI vide its circular ref. no. CIR/MIRSD/66/2016 dated July 21, 2016 and circular ref. no. CIR/MIRSD/120/2016 dated November 10, 2016 has prescribed that the Mutual Fund/ AMC should capture KYC information for sharing with CKYCR as per the KYC template prescribed by CERSAI.

In accordance with the aforesaid SEBI circulars and AMFI best practice guidelines for implementation of CKYC norms with effect from February 1, 2017:

- Individual investors who have never done KYC process under KRA regime i.e. a new investor who is new to KRA system and whose KYC is not registered or verified in the KRA system shall be required to provide KYC details in the CKYC Form to the Mutual Fund/ AMC.
- Individual investor who fills old KRA KYC Form, should provide additional / missing information using Supplementary KYC Form or fill CKYC Form.
- Details of investors shall be uploaded on the system of CKYCR and a 14 digit unique KYC identifier ('KIN') will be generated for such customer.
- New investors, who have completed KYC process & have obtained KIN may quote their KIN in the application form instead of submitting CKYC Form/ Supplementary KYC Form.
- AMC/ Mutual Fund shall use the KIN of the investor to download the KYC information from CKYCR system and update its records.
- If the PAN of investor is not updated on CKYCR system, the investor should submit self-certified copy of PAN card to the Mutual Fund/ AMC.

The CKYC Form and Supplementary KYC Form are available at Investor Service Centre (ISC) of PGIM India Mutual Fund and on website www.pgimindiamf.com.

The AMC reserves the right to reject transaction application in case the investor(s) fails to submit information and/or documentation as mentioned above. In the event of non compliance of KYC requirements, the Trustee / AMC reserves the right to freeze the folio of the investor(s).

• Micro Investment

With effect from October 30, 2012, where the aggregate of the lump sum investment (fresh purchase & additional purchase) and Micro SIP installments by an investor in a financial year i.e. April to March does not exceed Rs. 50,000/- it shall be exempt from the requirement of PAN. However, requirements of Know Your Customer (KYC) shall be mandatory.

Accordingly, investors seeking the above exemption for PAN still need to submit the KYC Acknowledgement, irrespective of the amount of investment. This exemption will be available only to Micro investment made by the individuals being Indian citizens (including NRIs, Joint holders, minors acting through guardian and sole proprietary firms), PIOs, HUFs, QFIs and other categories of investors will not be eligible for this exemption.

- Please furnish the full postal address of the Sole/ First Applicant with PIN/Postal Code and complete contact details. (P.O. Box address is not sufficient).
- Please note that all communication i.e. Account statement, Annual Report, News Letters will be sent via e-mail, if the e-mail id of the investor is provided in the application form. The Account statement will be encrypted with a password before sending the same to the registered email id. Should the unitholder face any difficulty in accessing/opening the Account Statements/ documents sent via email, the unitholder may call/write to the AMC/Registrar and ask for a physical copy.

5. INVESTMENT/PAYMENT DETAILS

Introduction of Direct Plan:-

The AMC has introduced a separate plan for direct investments (i.e. investments not routed through an AMFI Registration Number (ARN) Holder ("Distributor") (hereinafter referred to as "Direct Plan") with effect from January 1, 2013 ("Effective Date").

- Direct Plan is only for investors who purchase /subscribe Units in a Scheme directly with the Fund and is not available for investors who route their investments through a Distributor.
- Investors may please note that the Direct Plan under the Schemes is meant for investors who understand the capital market, mutual funds and the risks associated therewith. The risks associated with the investments in the Schemes vary depending upon the investment objective, asset allocation and investment strategy of the Schemes and the investments may not be suited for all categories of

investors. The AMC believes that investors investing under the Direct Plan of the Schemes are aware of the investment objective, asset allocation, investment strategy, risks associated therewith and other features of the Schemes and has taken an informed investment decision. Please note that Scheme Information Document(s), Statement of Additional Information, Key Information Memorandum or any other advertisements and its contents are for information only and do not constitute any investment advice or solicitation or offer for sale of units of the Schemes from the AMC.

- All Options/Sub-Options offered under the Schemes (hereinafter referred as "Regular Plan") will also be available for subscription under the Direct Plan. Thus, from the Effective Date, there shall be 2 Plans available for subscription under the Schemes viz., Regular Plan and Direct Plan.
- Investors subscribing under Direct Plan of the Schemes should indicate the Scheme/Plan name in the application form as "Scheme Name – Direct Plan" form for e.g. "PGIM India Midcap Opportunities Fund Direct Plan". Investors should also indicate "Direct" in the ARN column of the application form. However, in case Distributor code is mentioned in the application form, but "Direct Plan" is indicated against the Scheme name, the Distributor code will be ignored and the application will be processed under Direct Plan.
- Please note, where application is received for Regular Plan without Distributor code or "Direct" mentioned in the ARN Column, the application will be processed under Direct Plan.
- Investment cheque is not mandatory if investor wish to start a SIP.
- Payment may be made only by Cheque or Bank Draft or Electronic Fund Transfer. Cheque/Draft should be drawn in favour of the "Scheme name", e.g. "PGIM India Midcap Opportunities Fund" and crossed "Account Payee only".
- Please tick and fill in the appropriate section based on the Type of Investment i.e. LUMPSUM or SIP or Micro investment. Please fill an Auto Debit form in case of investment through SIP - Auto Debit Facility. Please note that third party payments shall not be accepted.
- Third Party Payment" shall mean payment made through an instrument issued from an account other than that of the beneficiary investor. In case of payment instruments issued from a joint bank account, the first named applicant/investor must be one of the joint holders of the bank account from which the payment instrument is issued. 'Related person/s' means such persons as may be specified by the AMC from time to time. **Exceptions:** The AMC/ Registrar of PGIM IMF will accept subscriptions to schemes of PGIM IMF accompanied by Third-Party Payment Instruments only in the following exceptional cases:
 - Payment by employer on behalf of employee under Systematic Investment Plan (SIP) facility through payroll deductions;
 - Custodian on behalf of a ClientThe investors making an application under the above mentioned exceptional cases are required to comply with the following, without which their applications for subscriptions for units will be rejected / not processed.
- Mandatory KYC compliance of the investor and the person making the payment, in order to determine the identity of the investor and the person issuing the payment instrument.
- Submit a separate, prescribed, 'Third Party Payment Declaration Form' from the beneficiary applicant/s and the person making the payment i.e., the Third Party, giving details of the bank account from which the payment is made and the relationship of the Third Party with the beneficiary. (The declaration form is available at www.pgimindiamf.com)
- Submit a cancelled cheque leaf or copy of bank statement / pass book page mentioning bank account number, account holders' name and address or such other document as the AMC may require for verifying the source of funds to ascertain that funds have been remitted from the drawer's account only.

For identifying Third Party Payments, investors are required to comply with the requirements specified below :

- Payment by Cheque: An investor at the time of his/her purchase must provide the details of pay-in bank account (i.e. account from which a subscription payment is made) and pay-out bank account (i.e. account into which redemption/dividend proceeds are to be paid). Identification of third party cheques by the AMC / Registrars will be on the basis of either matching of pay-in bank account details with registered/pay-out bank account details or by matching the bank account number/name/signature of the first named investor with the name/account number/signature available on the cheque. If the name/bank account number is not pre-printed on the cheque and signature on the cheque does not match with signature on the application, then the first named applicant/investor should submit any one of the following documents:
 - a copy# of the bank passbook or a statement of bank account having the name and address of the account holder and account number;
 - a letter* (in original) from the bank on the bank's letterhead certifying that the investor maintains an account with the bank, alongwith information like bank account number, bank branch, account type, the MICR code of the branch & IFSC Code (where available).*In respect of (ii) above, it should be certified by the bank manager with his/her full signature, name, employee code, bank seal and contact number. Investors should note that where the bank account numbers have changed on account of the implementation of core banking system at their banks, any related communication from the bank towards a change in bank account number should accompany the application form for subscription of units.
- Payment by Prefunded Instrument:
 - If the subscription is settled with pre-funded instruments such as Pay Order, Demand Draft, Banker's cheque, etc., a certificate (in original) from the Issuing banker must accompany the purchase application, stating the Account holder's name and the Account number which has been debited for issue of the instrument. The account number mentioned in the Certificate should be a registered bank account or the first named unitholder should be one of the account holders to the bank account debited for issue of such instruments.
 - This also should be accompanied by a certificate from the banker giving name, address and PAN of the person who has procured the payment instrument. The Certificate(s) mentioned in (i) and (ii) above should be duly certified by the bank manager with his/her full signature, name, employee code, bank seal and contact number.
- Payment by RTGS, NEFT, ECS, Bank transfer, etc:

A copy of the instruction to the bank stating the account number debited must accompany the purchase application. The account number mentioned on the transfer instruction copy should be a registered bank account or the first named unitholder should be one of the account holders to the bank account.

The above broadly covers the various modes of payment for mutual fund subscriptions. The above list is only indicative not exhaustive list and any other mode of payment as introduced from time to time will also be covered accordingly. In case the application for subscription does not comply with the above provisions, the AMC / Registrars retains the Sole and absolute discretion to reject/not process such application and refund the subscription money and shall not be liable for any such rejection.

I. LUMPSUM INVESTMENT

If you are from a city where there is no designated Investor Service Centre of PGIM IMF, you may make a payment by a Demand Draft for the investment amount. Please enter the cheque or DD amount, DD Charges (if applicable) and the investment amount. The AMC shall bear the DD Charges incurred by an applicant as per demand draft charges prescribed by State Bank of India. The AMC shall, however, not refund any DD charges to the investor under any circumstances.

II. INVESTMENT UNDER SIP

a. The following criteria should be met for an SIP investment as specified in the SID and any addenda issued there to :

- Minimum amount per instalment
- Minimum number of instalments
- Aggregate investment via SIP

If the SIP period is not specified by the investor then the SIP enrolment will be deemed to be for perpetuity and processed accordingly. The SIP facility will be available on the following dates in a Month or Quarter as chosen by the investor : All dates available of the month except 29/30/31. If any of the said dates happen to be a holiday / non-transaction day, then the SIP transaction will be processed on the next business day.

- b. SIP Mode – Auto Debit (ECS/Direct Debit/NACH) OR Post-Dated Cheques
- c. For SIP application, the first investment cheque is optional. However, an original cancelled cheque is mandatory to verify the SIP bank details.
- d. The first instalment (in case investor wishes to make the first investment with the SIP application form) you may pay either through Auto Debit (ECS/Direct Debit/NACH) or by Post Dated Cheques. If you wish to opt for payments through Auto Debit, please indicate your preference for SIP through Auto Debit (ECS/Direct Debit/NACH) in the box provided for the purpose and fill in the attached AUTO DEBIT FACILITY FORM. If you wish to pay for your future SIPs through Post Dated Cheques (PDC), you should not fill in the AUTO DEBIT FACILITY FORM. Please mention the second and subsequent Instalment cheque details in the space provided for the purpose.
- e. The first instalment cheque should be dated with the date of submission of the Application Form. Please note the following:
- For SIPs through PDCs, the first SIP cheque needs to be from the same bank account as the PDC's for your future SIP Instalments.
 - The Second SIP Instalment has to be at least 20 days in case direct debit and 30 days in case of ECS after the date of the first SIP Instalment.
 - The first Instalment cheque and the subsequent Instalments (either through PDCs or Auto Debit) should be for the same amount.
- f. Please note that the Cheque should be made favoring the scheme name. (For e.g. "PGIM India Large Cap Fund").
- g. In case of SIP through Auto Debit, the Auto Debit Authorisation needs to be filled in and signed by the Bank Account holders in the same order and manner in which the Bank account is held by them.
- h. In case of any mismatch between the 'No. of instalment' and the 'SIP period', the SIP period will be considered as per the Auto Debit Facility Form.
- i. In case of any discrepancy between the Application Form and the Auto Debit Facility Form, the SIP details provided in the latter will be considered for investment.

6. BANK DETAILS

- a. Please furnish complete Bank Account Details of the Sole/First Applicant. This is a mandatory requirement and applications not carrying bank account details shall be rejected. Bank details provided in the application form will be considered as the default Bank Mandate for remitting redemption proceeds/dividend amount.
- b. Please provide your complete Core Banking Account Number, (if applicable), in your Bank Mandate in the Application Form. In case you are not aware of the Core Banking Account Number, kindly check the same with your bankers.
- c. Please attach a original cancelled cheque leaf if your investment instrument is not from the same bank account mentioned in the Application form.
- d. PGIM India Mutual Fund will endeavour to remit the Redemption and Dividend proceeds through electronic mode, wherever sufficient bank account details of the unit holder are available.

7. FOREIGN ACCOUNT TAX COMPLIANCE (FATCA)

FATCA & CRS TERMS & CONDITIONS: Details under FATCA & CRS: The Central Board of Direct Taxes has notified Rules 114F to 114H, as part of the Income- tax Rules, 1962, which Rules require Indian financial institutions such as the Bank to seek additional personal, tax and beneficial owner information and certain certifications and documentation from all our account holders. In relevant cases, information will have to be reported to tax authorities / appointed agencies. Towards compliance, we may also be required to provide information to any institutions such as withholding agents for the purpose of ensuring appropriate withholding from the account or any proceeds in relation thereto.

Should there be any change in any information provided by you, please ensure you advise us promptly, i.e., within 30 days.

Please note that you may receive more than one request for information if you have multiple relationships with PGIM India Mutual Fund or its group entities. Therefore, it is important that you respond to our request, even if you believe you have already supplied any previously requested information.

FATCA & CRS INSTRUCTIONS: If you have any questions about your tax residency, please contact your tax advisor. If you are a US citizen or resident or greencard holder, please include United States in the foreign country information field along with your US Tax Identification Number.

It is mandatory to supply a TIN or functional equivalent if the country in which you are tax resident issues such identifiers. If no TIN is yet available or has not yet been issued, please provide an explanation and attach this to the form.

SEBI issued its circular no. CIR/MIRSD/2/2015 dated August 26, 2015 interalia advising intermediaries to take necessary steps to ensure compliance with the requirements specified in the rules and guidelines specified by the Government of India. AMFI also issued its best practices guidelines circular no. 63/2015-16 dated September 18, 2015 on this matter. The AMC and the Mutual Fund are required to adhere to various requirements interalia including submission of various information / details relating to the investors in the schemes of the mutual fund, to authorities, as specified under the applicable laws. Accordingly, the following aspects need to be adhered to :

- With effect from November 1, 2015 all investors will have to mandatorily provide the information and declarations pertaining to FATCA/CRS for all new accounts opened, failing which the application / transaction request shall be liable to be rejected.
- For all new accounts opened by investors, from September 1, 2015 till October 31, 2015, MFs need to obtain relevant FATCA declarations. These details / certification need to be obtained by December 31, 2015, particularly in cases where, after Indicia search, a positive match is found with any US indicia. If self-certification is not provided by an investor or the reasonableness of self-certification cannot be confirmed, the account is treated as reportable.
- For accounts opened between July 1, 2014 and August 31, 2015, the Government of India vide its press release dated April 11, 2017 has required that all efforts should be made by the AMC to obtain the self-certification from the investor. Further, in case selfcertifications are not provided by unitholders till April 30, 2017, the folios would be blocked, which would mean that the AMC would prohibit the unitholder from effecting any transaction with respect to such folios. For pre-existing accounts (as on December 31, 2015 in case of CRS and June 30, 2014 in case of FATCA), specific investors above specified threshold limits would be required to provide self-certification forms.

Investors are requested to provide all the necessary information / declarations to facilitate compliance, considering India's commitment to implement CRS and FATCA under the relevant international treaties.

Please consult your professional tax advisor for further guidance on your tax residency, if required.

8. NOMINATION DETAILS

You may nominate a maximum of 3 persons, to receive the Units/amounts standing to your credit payable in the event of death of the Unit Holder(s) in respect of investment under a folio.

- The nomination may be made only by individuals applying for/holding units on their own behalf, singly or jointly.
- Non-individuals including society, trust, body corporate, partnership firm, Karta of HUF, holder of POA or a parent/guardian applying on behalf of a minor beneficiary cannot nominate.
- Nomination can also be in favour of the Central Government, State Government, and a local authority, any person designated by virtue of his office or a religious or charitable trust.
- The Nominee shall not be a trust (other than a religious or charitable trust), society, body corporate, partnership firm, Karta of Hindu Undivided Family or a Power of Attorney holder.
- A Non-Resident Indian can be a Nominee subject to the exchange control regulations in force, from time to time.
- Transfer of units in favour of a Nominee shall be valid discharge by the AMC/Mutual Fund against the legal heir.
- The cancellation of nomination can be made only by the individual(s) who hold units on their own behalf singly or jointly and who made the original nomination. On cancellation of the nomination, the nomination shall stand rescinded and the AMC shall not be under any obligation to transfer the units in favour of the Nominee.
- In the event of the unit holders not indicating the percentage of allocation/share for each of the nominees, the AMC shall settle the claim equally amongst all the nominees
- It is recommended for the nominee to provide the signature in the space provided.
- Investors should opt for the nomination facility to avoid hassles and inconveniences in case of unforeseen events in future.
- Nomination by a Unit holder shall be applicable for all the investments in all schemes held in a particular folio.
- Every new nomination for a folio will overwrite the existing nomination
- Nomination shall be mandatory for all new singly held folios of individual investors.
- In case of multiple nominees, the percentage of allocation/share in whole numbers and without decimals in favour of each of the nominees should be indicated against the name of the nominees. Such allocation/ share should total to 100 percent. In the event of the Unit holder(s) fail to indicate the

percentage of allocation/share for each of the nominees, the Fund/ AMC, by invoking default option shall settle the claim equally amongst all the nominees.

In case you do not wish to nominate, kindly indicate by ticking in the space provided.

9. DECLARATION AND SIGNATURES

- Please tick the box provided for EUIN declaration in this section in case the ARN is mentioned in the distributor section and the EUIN is left blank.
- All signatures should be hand written in English or any Indian language. Thumb impressions should be from the left hand for males and the right hand for females and in both cases must be attested by a Judicial Magistrate or a Notary Public.
- If the application form is signed by a Power of Attorney (PoA) holder, the form should be accompanied by a notarised photocopy of the PoA. Alternatively, the original PoA may be submitted, which will be returned after verification. If the PoA is not submitted with the application, the Application Form will be rejected. The POA should contain the signature of the investor (POADonor) and the POA holder.

10. GO GREEN INITIATIVE IN MUTUAL FUNDS

11. IMPLEMENTATION OF AMENDMENTS IN INDIAN STAMP ACT, 1899

Investors / Unit Holders of all the Scheme(s) of the Mutual Fund pursuant to Notification No. S.O. 4419(E) dated December 10, 2019 issued by Department of Revenue, Ministry of Finance, Government of India, read with Part I of Chapter IV of Notification dated February 21, 2019 and Notification dated March 30, 2020 issued by Legislative Department, Ministry of Law and Justice, Government of India on the Finance Act, 2019, a stamp duty @ 0.005% of the transaction value would be levied on mutual fund transactions with effect from July 1, 2020. Accordingly, pursuant to levy of stamp duty, the number of units allotted on purchase, switch-ins, SIP/STP installments (including dividend reinvestment) to the unitholders would be reduced to that extent.
